



Typical Lap Times

The most commonly asked question is “what sort of lap time can be considered competitive at Lydd?” For those of you who would like an answer to this question the following list of best laps may prove beneficial and provide you with a yardstick by which to gauge your own performance. I should point out that unlike other times that you may see published or hear banded about, these times were achieved in actual races, with the karts in race trim, ballasted to the minimum weight for the class as necessary. The times were correct at the time of publication of this guide (1st June 2009). Times are for the two circuit layouts detailed above
